

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Transportation & Energy.

SB22-090 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, after line 10 insert:

2        "(b) "HEATING DEGREE DAYS" MEANS A MEASURE OF HOW COLD  
3 OR WARM A LOCATION IS IN COMPARISON TO A STANDARD TEMPERATURE,  
4 WHICH STANDARD TEMPERATURE IS USUALLY SIXTY-FIVE DEGREES  
5 FAHRENHEIT IN THE UNITED STATES.".

6 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

7 Page 2, strike lines 14 through 21 and substitute "THE RETAIL UTILITY'S  
8 SERVICE TERRITORY, WHICH COMMUNICATION MUST BE SENT BY  
9 ELECTRONIC MAIL IN BOTH ENGLISH AND SPANISH AND, IF A CUSTOMER IS  
10 GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO OPT IN FOR AN ADDITIONAL METHOD OF  
11 COMMUNICATION REGARDING A SEVERE WEATHER EVENT AND DOES OPT  
12 IN, MAY BE SENT TO THE CUSTOMER BY TEXT MESSAGE OR PHONE CALL  
13 BASED ON THE CUSTOMER'S INDICATED PREFERENCE BETWEEN THE TWO.".

14 Page 3, strike line 5 and substitute "CUSTOMERS.".

15 Page 3, line 6, after "(e)" insert "(I)".

16 Page 3, after line 6 insert:

17        "(II) "UTILITY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A MUNICIPALLY OWNED  
18 NATURAL GAS OR ELECTRIC UTILITY OR A POWER AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED  
19 PURSUANT TO SECTION 29-1-204.".

20 Page 3, line 7, after "2022," insert "AND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION  
21 (2)(a)(II) OF THIS SECTION,".

22 Page 3, after line 19 insert:

23        "(II) A RETAIL UTILITY SHALL PROVIDE NOTIFICATION UNDER  
24 SUBSECTION (2)(a)(I) OF THIS SECTION IF THE FORECASTED USAGE  
25 EXCEEDS SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE DESIGN DAY HEATING DEGREE  
26 DAYS.".

27 Renumber succeeding subparagraph accordingly.
