

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Health & Human Services.

SB23-162 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 15 through 19 and substitute "~~rule~~:"
- 2 PERFORMING POINT-OF-CARE TESTING AND PATIENT CARE TECHNICAL
- 3 TASKS AS SPECIFICALLY TRAINED FOR AND DELEGATED BY A SUPERVISING
- 4 PHARMACIST; AND".

- 5 Page 3, lines 10 and 11, strike "**amend** (3); and".

- 6 Page 3, strike lines 14 through 27 and substitute "**technicians.** (1) A
- 7 pharmacist may supervise up to six persons who are either pharmacy
- 8 interns or pharmacy technicians, of whom no more than two may be
- 9 pharmacy interns. If three or more pharmacy technicians are on duty, the
- 10 majority must be FULLY certified by the board in accordance with section
- 11 12-280-115.5 (2), and any pharmacy technician on duty who is not
- 12 certified pursuant to section 12-280-115.5 (2) must have a provisional
- 13 certification issued pursuant to section 12-280-115.5 (3).
- 14 (4)(a) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION APPLY
- 15 TO A CENTRAL FILL PHARMACY; EXCEPT THAT A PHARMACIST MAY
- 16 SUPERVISE UP TO EIGHT PERSONS WHO ARE EITHER PHARMACY INTERNS OR
- 17 PHARMACY TECHNICIANS.
- 18 (b) AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4), A "CENTRAL FILL PHARMACY"
- 19 MEANS A PHARMACY, OTHER THAN A PHARMACY LOCATED IN A HOSPITAL
- 20 LICENSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 25-1.5-103, THAT IS NOT A
- 21 PUBLIC-FACING PHARMACY AND THAT ONLY ACTS AS AN AGENT OF AN
- 22 ORIGINATING PHARMACY TO FILL OR REFILL A PRESCRIPTION."

- 23 Page 4, strike lines 1 and 2.

- 24 Page 4, strike lines 14 through 23.

- 25 Renumber succeeding subparagraphs accordingly.

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
