Second Reading

- 1 Amend the Agriculture, Water, and Natural Resources Committee Report,
2 dated April 21, 2025, page 2, strike line 2 and substitute:
- 3 "Page 9 of the printed bill, line 9, strike "pursue" and substitute
4 "consider".
- 5 Page 9 of the bill, strike line 14 and substitute "consider opportunities to
6 expand conservation, restoration, and sustainably managed public access
7 to".
- 8 Page 2 of the report, after line 6 insert:
- 9 "Page 10 of the bill, line 2, after "The" insert "state board of land
10 commissioners has generated significant and important revenue for the
11 public beneficiaries of the state trust lands. The".
- 12 Page 10 of the bill, line 5, strike "both" and substitute "continuing
13 existing uses and".
- 14 Page 2 of the report, after line 10 insert:
- 15 "Page 11 of the bill, strike line 3 and substitute "VALUE".
- 16 Page 11 of the bill, line 12, strike "ABILITY" and substitute "OPTION".
- 17 Page 11 of the bill, line 17, strike "A MANNER" and substitute "MANNERS
18 THAT PRODUCE REASONABLE AND CONSISTENT INCOME OVER TIME AND".
- 19 Page 2 of the report, line 22, after "AGRICULTURE," insert "MINERAL
20 LEASING AND DEVELOPMENT, RECLAMATION,".
- 21 Page 4 of the report, before line 36 insert:
- 22 "Page 14 of the bill, line 22, strike "BETTER".
- 23 Page 15 of the bill, strike lines 6 through 12 and substitute
24 "RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES ON STATE TRUST LANDS, INCLUDING AN
25 EVALUATION OF HOW TO MINIMIZE IMPACTS OF RECREATIONAL ACCESS ON
26 EXISTING AGRICULTURAL LEASES OF STATE TRUST LANDS; AND
27 (V) IDENTIFY MANAGEMENT OPTIONS FOR THE UTILIZATION OF
28 NATURAL RESOURCES ON STATE TRUST LANDS TO CONSERVE THE

1 LONG-TERM VALUE OF THE STATE TRUST LANDS WHILE THE STATE BOARD
2 OF LAND COMMISSIONERS CARRIES OUT ITS FIDUCIARY DUTIES.".

3 Page 15 of the bill, line 15, strike "LANDS." and substitute "LANDS OR TO
4 LIMIT THE STATE BOARD'S ABILITY TO CONTINUE USING A MULTIPLE-USE
5 MANAGEMENT APPROACH FOR CONSIDERATION OF FUTURE LEASES ON
6 STATE TRUST LANDS.".
