

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

BY REPRESENTATIVE Young

1 Amend printed bill, page 16, line 16, strike "(5) and (6)" and substitute
2 "(5), (6), (7), (8), and (9)".

3 Page 17, after line 12 insert:

4 "(6) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS SCHOOL PERSONNEL
5 FROM TAKING ANY LAWFUL ACTIONS NECESSARY, INCLUDING SECLUSION
6 OR RESTRAINT, WHEN AND WHERE NECESSARY TO KEEP STUDENTS AND
7 STAFF SAFE FROM HARM DURING AN EMERGENCY, AS DEFINED BY RULE OF
8 THE STATE BOARD. SCHOOL PERSONNEL SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL
9 DOCUMENTATION AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, EVEN IN THE CASE OF
10 AN EMERGENCY.

11 (7) IF A PHYSICAL RESTRAINT IS BETWEEN ONE AND FIVE MINUTES,
12 THE NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT MUST BE A WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE
13 PARENT ON THE DAY OF THE RESTRAINT. THE NOTICE MUST INCLUDE THE
14 DATE, THE STUDENT'S NAME, AND THE NUMBER OF RESTRAINTS THAT DAY
15 THAT LASTED BETWEEN ONE AND FIVE MINUTES.

16 (8) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2023, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
17 SHALL CONVENE A STAKEHOLDER GROUP TO DRAFT RULES FOR REPORTING
18 RESTRAINTS FROM ONE TO FIVE MINUTES AND DATA TO BE COLLECTED BY
19 THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL
20 PRESENT THESE RULES TO THE STATE BOARD FOR CONSIDERATION ON OR
21 BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2023. THE STAKEHOLDER GROUP MUST INCLUDE,
22 BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE GENERAL
23 EDUCATION ADMINISTRATION, A STATEWIDE ORGANIZATION
24 REPRESENTING SPECIAL EDUCATION DIRECTORS, THE DEPARTMENT OF
25 EDUCATION, AND A DISABILITY RIGHTS ORGANIZATION."

26 Page 17, line 13, strike "(6)" and substitute "(9)".

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
