

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.

SB22-183 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 4, line 20, strike "SERVICES" and substitute
2 "AND CULTURALLY RESPONSIVE SERVICES BY PROVIDERS FROM DIVERSE
3 CULTURAL BACKGROUNDS".

4 Page 12, before line 27, insert:

5 "SECTION 8. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-4.1-117.3,
6 **amend** (2)(c) and (2)(e) as follows:

7 **24-4.1-117.3. Crime victim services advisory board - creation**
8 **- duties.** (2) (c) The term of office for each member of the advisory
9 board ~~shall be~~ IS three years. ~~except that, of the members first appointed,~~
10 ~~six members shall be appointed to serve one-year terms and six members~~
11 ~~shall be appointed to serve two-year terms.~~ A MEMBER SHALL NOT SERVE
12 MORE THAN THREE CONSECUTIVE THREE-YEAR TERMS. A MEMBER OF THE
13 ADVISORY BOARD ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SENATE BILL 22-183,
14 ENACTED IN 2022, WHO HAS SERVED MORE THAN THREE CONSECUTIVE
15 TERMS MAY SERVE THE REMAINDER OF THE MEMBER'S CURRENT TERM,
16 BUT SHALL NOT SERVE A CONSECUTIVE SUBSEQUENT TERM.

17 (e) ~~The executive director shall appoint the initial members of the~~
18 ~~advisory board on or before August 1, 2009.~~ The executive director may
19 reappoint a person to serve ~~an unlimited number of consecutive terms.~~
20 SUBSEQUENT TERMS ON THE ADVISORY BOARD, BUT THE EXECUTIVE
21 DIRECTOR SHALL NOT APPOINT A PERSON TO SERVE MORE THAN THREE
22 CONSECUTIVE TERMS. The executive director shall annually appoint a
23 chairperson of the advisory board who shall preside over the advisory
24 board's meetings."
