3 Page 1, line 19, strike "PARCEL MAP" and substitute "SITE PLAN".

4 Page 1, line 24, strike "PARCEL MAP" and substitute "SITE PLAN".

5 Page 2, line 2, strike "CAPITAL." and substitute "CAPITAL".

6 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-219, **add**
7 (7)(g) and (7)(h) as follows:

8 **24-75-219. Transfers - transportation - capital construction -**
9 **definitions - repeal.** (7) In addition to any other transfers required by
10 this section:

11 (g)(I) ON JUNE 15, 2022, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER
12 ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL
13 FUND TO THE SOUTHWEST CHIEF RAIL LINE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
14 RURAL TOURISM, AND INFRASTRUCTURE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE FUND
15 CREATED IN SECTION 43-4-1002.

16 (II) THIS SUBSECTION (7)(g) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022.

17 (h)(I) ON JULY 1, 2022, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER:

18 (A) SIX MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE
19 GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND. THE DEPARTMENT OF
20 TRANSPORTATION SHALL EXPEND THIS AMOUNT IN CONNECTION WITH THE
21 DEVELOPMENT OF THE BURNHAM YARD RAIL PROPERTY FOR THE
22 PURPOSES OF COMPLETING AN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT ON
23 RELOCATING THE CONSOLIDATED MAIN RAIL LINE AWAY FROM INTERSTATE
24 HIGHWAY 25; AND

25 (B) FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND
26 TO THE UNUSED STATE-OWNED REAL PROPERTY FUND CREATED IN SECTION
27 24-82-102.5 (5)(a).

28 (II) THIS SUBSECTION (7)(h) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
29 2023.".

30 Page 2, strike lines 5 through 9 and substitute:

31 **"SECTION 7. Effective date.** (1) Except as otherwise provided
32 in this section, this act takes effect upon passage.

33 (2) Sections 2 and 3 of this act take effect only if Senate Bill
34 22-130 becomes law, in which case sections 2 and 3 take effect upon the
35 effective date of this act or Senate Bill 22-130, whichever is later.
