

SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated March 31, 2022, page 3,
2 lines 3 through 10, strike "Subject to annual appropriation by the general
3 assembly, the department may expend money from the fund for the
4 purposes of this section. The department may use up to five percent of the
5 money annually appropriated to the fund to pay the direct and indirect
6 costs that the department incurs in administering the grant program. THE
7 MONEY IN THE FUND IS CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR THE DIRECT
8 AND INDIRECT COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS
9 SECTION."." and substitute "Subject to annual appropriation by the general
10 assembly, the department may expend money from the fund for the
11 purposes of this section. ANY UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED MONEY
12 FROM AN APPROPRIATION MADE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION
13 REMAINS AVAILABLE FOR EXPENDITURE BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE
14 NEXT TWO FISCAL YEARS WITHOUT FURTHER APPROPRIATION. The
15 department may use up to five percent of the money annually
16 appropriated to the fund to pay the direct and indirect costs that the
17 department incurs in administering the grant program.".".

18 Amend the Appropriations Committee Report, dated April 22, 2022, page
19 1, after line 8 insert:
20 "(2) For the 2022-23 fiscal year, \$5,000,000 is appropriated to the
21 department of local affairs. This appropriation is from reappropriated
22 funds in the peace officers behavioral health and community partnership
23 fund pursuant to subsection (1) of this section and is based on the
24 assumption that the department will require an additional 2.5 FTE. To
25 implement this act, the department may use the appropriation for the
26 peace officers mental health support grant program.".
