HB22-1111 be amended as follows:

- 12 TO AN EMPLOYEE OF THE INSURER;".

- 13 Page 3 of the amendment, line 19, strike "INSURED" and substitute
- 14 "POLICYHOLDER".

- 15 Page 3 of the amendment, strike lines 27 through 31 and substitute:
