- 1 Amend corrected printed bill, page 10, after line 1 insert:
- 2 **"SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 25-4-911 as
- 3 follows:
- 4 **25-4-911. Required disclosure.** (1) A LICENSED PHYSICIAN, A
- 5 LICENSED ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE AUTHORIZED UNDER SECTION
- 6 12-36-106(5), OR AN ADVANCE PRACTICE NURSE THAT ADMINISTERS ANY
- 7 IMMUNIZATION REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS PART 9 SHALL PROVIDE THE
- 8 FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO THE STUDENT'S PARENT OR LEGAL
- 9 GUARDIAN, OR THE EMANCIPATED STUDENT OR STUDENT EIGHTEEN YEARS
- 10 OF AGE OR OLDER, PRIOR TO ADMINISTERING AN IMMUNIZATION:
 - 11 (a) THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF IMMUNIZATIONS;
 - 12 (b) THE IMMUNIZATION MANUFACTURER'S PRODUCT INSERT;
 - 13 (c) THE IMMUNIZATION'S EXCIPIENT AND MEDIA SUMMARY,
 - 14 PUBLISHED BY THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND
 - 15 PREVENTION; AND
 - 16 (d) HOW, AND TO WHOM, TO REPORT AN IMMUNIZATION-ADVERSE
 - 17 EVENT.
- 18 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT
- 19 SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON ANY INFORMATIONAL
- 20 MATERIALS IT DEVELOPS CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS:
 - 21 (a) THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF IMMUNIZATIONS;
 - 22 (b) THE IMMUNIZATION MANUFACTURER'S PRODUCT INSERT;
 - 23 (c) THE IMMUNIZATION'S EXCIPIENT AND MEDIA SUMMARY,
 - 24 PUBLISHED BY THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND
 - 25 PREVENTION; AND
 - 26 (d) HOW, AND TO WHOM, TO REPORT AN IMMUNIZATION-ADVERSE
 - 27 EVENT.".
