## SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

BY SENATOR Gonzales J.

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, after line 2 insert:

2 "(II) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL, AT LEAST THIRTY DAYS PRIOR TO  
3 RELOCATING ANY INMATES PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(b.6)(I) OF THIS  
4 SECTION, PROVIDE A STRUCTURED RELOCATION PLAN TO THE JOINT  
5 BUDGET COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES JUDICIARY  
6 COMMITTEE AND THE SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, OR THEIR  
7 SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, AND SHALL UPDATE THOSE COMMITTEES DURING  
8 THE PROJECT. THE PLAN MUST INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO:

9 (A) WHAT SPECIFIC EDUCATIONAL, REHABILITATIVE, AND  
10 VOCATIONAL PROGRAMS OR CLASSES WILL BE AVAILABLE TO THE  
11 INMATES, INCLUDING THE TYPE OF PROGRAMS, THE NUMBER OF INMATES  
12 THAT CAN BE ENROLLED IN EACH PROGRAM, THE LENGTH OF EACH  
13 PROGRAM, AND THE LOCATION WHERE EACH PROGRAM WILL BE  
14 DELIVERED;

15 (B) WHAT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE WILL BE  
16 AVAILABLE;

17 (C) WHAT EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES WILL BE AVAILABLE AND  
18 THE RATE OF PAY FOR EACH EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY;

19 (D) WHAT RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES WILL BE AVAILABLE,  
20 INCLUDING THE LOCATION AND LENGTH OF TIME THAT AN INMATE WILL BE  
21 ABLE TO ACCESS THE RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES;

22 (E) WHAT VISITATION OPPORTUNITIES WILL BE AVAILABLE, HOW  
23 OFTEN THEY WILL BE AVAILABLE, THE LOCATION FOR VISITATION, AND  
24 WHETHER THAT VISITATION IS CONTACT OR NON-CONTACT;

25 (F) HOW MANY HOURS A DAY AN INMATE WILL BE ALLOWED OUT  
26 OF THEIR CELL BASED ON THEIR MEDIUM OR CLOSE CUSTODY LEVEL OR  
27 PROTECTIVE CUSTODY STATUS;

28 (G) WHETHER, PRIOR TO TRANSFER, THE DEPARTMENT PLANS TO  
29 CONDUCT A RECLASSIFICATION OR OTHER CUSTODY REVIEW ON ANY  
30 MEDIUM SECURITY INMATE TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE INMATE IS  
31 APPROPRIATE TO PROGRESS OR HAVE AN OVERRIDE TO  
32 MINIMUM-RESTRICTIVE CUSTODY; AND

33 (H) AN ESTIMATE OF HOW LONG INMATES WILL BE TEMPORARILY  
34 HELD AT CENTENNIAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY-SOUTH C-TOWER AND IF  
35 THE RELOCATIONS WILL BE BASED ON THE DURATION OF THE ACCESS  
36 CONTROLS PROJECT AT THE STERLING CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

37 (III) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE UPDATES ON THE STATUS  
38 OF THE ACCESS CONTROLS PROJECT AT ITS "SMART ACT" HEARING  
39 REQUIRED BY SECTION 2-7-203."

40 Reletter succeeding subparagraph accordingly.
