

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

1 Amend engrossed joint resolution, page 4, after line 22, add:

2 "(d) IMMEDIATELY UPON THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE
3 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL INVOKING JOINT RULE 44, A JOINT COMMITTEE
4 EMERGENCY DECLARATION COMMITTEE MUST BE CREATED CONSISTING OF
5 FOUR REPRESENTATIVES, TWO FROM EACH MAJOR PARTY, AND FOUR
6 SENATORS, TWO FROM EACH MAJOR PARTY. MEMBERS WILL BE SELECTED
7 FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE PARTY LEADERSHIP TO SERVE FOR THE DURATION
8 OF THE EMERGENCY. THE CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE WILL
9 BE CHOSEN BY THE MAJORITY OF THE COMMITTEE AND MUST REPRESENT
10 BOTH MAJOR PARTIES. THEY SHALL MEET NO LESS THAN ONCE EVERY TEN
11 DAYS DURING THE DURATION OF THE EMERGENCY TO ASSESS THE STATE
12 OF THE EMERGENCY AND TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE STATUTORY
13 REQUIREMENTS OF PART 7 OF ARTICLE 33.5 OF TITLE 24, COLORADO
14 REVISED STATUTES, ARE STILL SATISFIED. THE COMMITTEE MUST REPORT
15 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE NO LESS THAN
16 ONCE EVERY FOURTEEN DAYS DURING THE DURATION OF THE DECLARED
17 EMERGENCY. THE COMMITTEE HAS THE AUTHORITY TO CALL WITNESSES
18 AND MUST ALLOW PUBLIC PARTICIPATION. AT WHICH TIME THE MAJORITY
19 AGREES THAT AN EMERGENCY NO LONGER EXISTS, THE COMMITTEE SHALL
20 REPORT TO THE ASSEMBLIES OF THE HOUSE AND SENATE THEIR FINDINGS
21 AND PRESENT A RESOLUTION TO THE MAJORITY OF THE HOUSE OF
22 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE TO DECLARE AN END TO THE
23 EMERGENCY.".
