1 Amend the Energy & Environment Committee Report, dated April 14,
2 2022, page 4, strike lines 31 through 34 and substitute:

3 "Page 22 of the printed bill, strike lines 12 through 27.

4 Page 23 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 3 and substitute:

5 "(3.5) (a) (I) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2025, THE DIVISION SHALL
6 ADOPT AND ENFORCE AN ENERGY CODE THAT ACHIEVES EQUIVALENT OR
7 BETTER ENERGY PERFORMANCE THAN THE 2021 INTERNATIONAL ENERGY
8 CONSERVATION CODE AND THE MODEL ELECTRIC READY AND SOLAR
9 READY CODE LANGUAGE IDENTIFIED FOR ADOPTION BY THE ENERGY CODE
10 ADVISORY BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-38.5-113 (5)(b). THIS
11 ENERGY CODE MUST APPLY TO FACTORY-BUILT STRUCTURES AND HOTELS,
12 MOTELS, AND MULTI-FAMILY STRUCTURES IN AREAS OF THE STATE WHERE
13 NO CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS FOR HOTELS, MOTELS, AND MULTI-FAMILY
14 STRUCTURES EXIST.

15 (II) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2030, THE DIVISION SHALL ADOPT
16 AND ENFORCE AN ENERGY CODE THAT ACHIEVES EQUIVALENT OR BETTER
17 ENERGY AND CARBON EMISSIONS PERFORMANCE THAN THE MODEL LOW
18 ENERGY AND CARBON CODE IDENTIFIED FOR ADOPTION BY THE ENERGY
19 CODE ADVISORY BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-38.5-113 (5)(c). THIS
20 ENERGY CODE MUST APPLY TO FACTORY-BUILT STRUCTURES AND HOTELS,
21 MOTELS, AND MULTI-FAMILY STRUCTURES IN AREAS OF THE STATE WHERE
22 NO CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS FOR HOTELS, MOTELS, AND MULTI-FAMILY
23 STRUCTURES EXIST."."

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
