SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 26-005

101 **CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF "COLORADO 4-H DAY".**

1 WHEREAS, 4-H is America's largest youth development
2 organization, having supported almost 6 million youth across the country
3 thus far; and

4 WHEREAS, 4-H helps Colorado youth develop the "four Hs":
5 Head, Heart, Hands, and Health; and

6 WHEREAS, 4-H annually reaches over 110,000 youth in
7 Colorado, helping them become confident, independent, resilient, and
8 compassionate leaders; and

9 WHEREAS, 4-H is nationally delivered by Cooperative
10 Extension--a community of more than 100 public universities across the
11 nation, including the Colorado State University Extension--that provides

2 including health, science, agriculture, and citizenship; and

3 WHEREAS, 4-H's local network of over 10,000 volunteers and
4 almost 100 professionals provides caring and supportive mentoring to
5 Colorado youth, helping them to grow into true leaders, entrepreneurs,
6 and visionaries; now, therefore,

7 *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-fifth General Assembly
8 of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:*

9 That the General Assembly hereby declares Monday, January 26,
10 2026, to be "Colorado 4-H Day" in recognition of the 4-H program's
11 extraordinary efforts on behalf of Colorado's youth.
