Summary Information

Overview. The bill prohibits a member or a member-elect of the General Assembly from holding another elected office.

Types of impacts. The bill has no fiscal impact on state or local government.

Appropriations. No appropriation is required.

Summary of Legislation

The bill prohibits members and members-elect of the legislature from holding any other elected office while serving as a member of the General Assembly. The prohibition applies once the votes are certified for member-elects, or once the Secretary of State certifies a vacancy appointment.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Prohibiting a member of the General Assembly from holding another elected position does not affect revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government; therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
