**Overview.** The bill prohibits a member or a member-elect of the General Assembly from holding another elected office.

**Types of impacts.** The bill has no fiscal impact on state or local government.

## **Summary of Legislation**

---

The bill prohibits members and members-elect of the legislature from holding any other elected office while serving as a member of the General Assembly. The prohibition applies once the votes are certified for member-elects, or once the Secretary of State certifies a vacancy appointment.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

---

Prohibiting a member of the General Assembly from holding another elected position does not affect revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government; therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## **Effective Date**

---

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
