Summary Information

Overview. The bill requires administrative courts to accept and send certain orders or reports electronically.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires administrative courts to issue orders, notifications, or decisions and accept certain reports or responses by electronic means. This includes notices, responses, and decisions on adjudicatory hearings in front of an administrative law judge.

State Expenditures

To the extent the electronic submission of materials during administrative adjudicatory hearings streamline workload for administrative law judges and state parties involved in hearings, workload will decrease. Any decrease is assumed to be minimal and no change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
