Bill Summary

The bill requires the governor to appoint members of diverse groups to statewide boards, commissions, committees, and task forces authorized by the general assembly.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 24-20-115 as
3 follows:

4 **24-20-115. Appointments by the governor - diversity -**
5 **definition.** (1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS ANY
6 STATEWIDE BOARD, COMMISSION, COMMITTEE, OR TASK FORCE
7 AUTHORIZED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN WHICH ALL OF ITS MEMBERS
8 ARE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

9 (2) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022, WHEN MAKING APPOINTMENTS
10 TO OR FILLING VACANCIES OF ANY BOARD, THE GOVERNOR **SHALL MAKE**
11 **REASONABLE EFFORTS, TO THE EXTENT AN APPLICATION FOR BOARD**
12 **MEMBERSHIP IS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR, TO CONSIDER APPOINTING**
13 **MEMBERS THAT, ALONG WITH MEETING THE BOARD'S SPECIFIED**
14 **MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS, REFLECT THE GEOGRAPHIC AND**
15 **DEMOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF THE ENTIRE STATE, INCLUDING MEMBERS**
16 **FROM BOTH RURAL AND URBAN PARTS OF THE STATE, AND MEMBERS OF**
17 **DIVERSE POLITICAL, RACIAL, **DISABILITY**, AND CULTURAL GROUPS AND OF**
18 **DIVERSE SEXUAL ORIENTATIONS AND GENDERS.**

19 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
20 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
21 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
22 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
23 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
24 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
25 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

1 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
