The Education Committee Report (05/09/16) includes a strike below amendment that eliminates the need for charter schools to submit applications for all automatic waivers. The amendment requires the State Board of Education to review the list of automatic waivers in FY 2016-17 and at least every three years thereafter and to remove automatic waivers found to have unintended consequences in charter school performance. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the Education Committee Report may result in increased workload for the Department but that the amendment eliminates the need for an appropriation in FY 2016-17.
