J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision reducing the FY 2016-17 Long Bill appropriations for the Department of Public Safety by \$166,608 cash funds from fees paid for concealed carry permit applications. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require a reduction of 1.4 FTE.
