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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101     **CONCERNING MANDATORY ANNUAL TRAINING BY SAFE2TELL FOR**  
102     **SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER TRAINING.**

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**Bill Summary**

Under current law, a peace officer who works as a school resource officer is encouraged to complete a school resource officer training curriculum (training) identified by the P.O.S.T. board. The bill requires a peace officer to complete the training before working as a school resource officer or as soon as is reasonably possible if there is not sufficient time to complete the training before the school resource officer

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1     *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-31-606, add (4)**

3           as follows:

4           **24-31-606. Safe2tell program - creation - duties.**

5           (4) BEGINNING ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2024, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL

6           ANNUALLY CONVENE A TRAINING MEETING FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE

7           OFFICERS, AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 22-32-146, AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

8           TO DISCUSS BEST PRACTICES IN RESPONDING TO SAFE2TELL REPORTS,

9           INCLUDING DEFINING ROLES, COMMUNICATION ABOUT A REPORT,

10           OUTCOME REPORTING, AND TRAINING RESOURCES TO IMPROVE SCHOOL

11           RESOURCE OFFICERS' SUPPORT OF STUDENTS AND SCHOOL STAFF.

12           SAFE2TELL MAY CONDUCT A SURVEY TO COLLECT DATA AND DISCUSSIONS

13           REGARDING SAFE2TELL OPERATIONS.

14           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

15           determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

16           preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
