Violation of any of the provisions 42-4-903 (5) 45. of law regarding required signals for turning movements is a class A traffic infraction. Driving, Overtaking, and Passing 46. Drive on right side. Violation of any of the provisions of law making exceptions 42-4-1001 (4) to the requirement that vehicles drive on the right side is a class A traffic infraction. 47. Passing oncoming vehicles. Drinking an alcoholic beverage or 42-4-1305 (2) (c) possessing an open alcoholic beverage container while seated in the passenger area of a motor vehicle that is on a public highway is a class A traffic infraction. Open marijuana container. Any person in the passenger area of a motor 66. 42-4-1305.5 (2) (c) vehicle that is on a public highway or the right-of-way of a public highway and who knowingly uses or consumes marijuana or has in his or her possession an open marijuana container commits a class A traffic infraction. Other Traffic Offenses 67. Following fire apparatus prohibited. Following any fire apparatus traveling in 42-4-1403 response to a fire alarm closer than 500 feet or driving into or parking in a block where fire apparatus has stopped in answer to a fire alarm is a class A traffic infraction. 68.
