Pursuant to §39-22-1001(8)(b), C.R.S., the Department of Revenue hereby advises the Revisor of Statutes that the 2014 Colorado Individual Income Tax return shall provide 15 lines for voluntary contributions to the following charitable organizations:

12. Colorado Multiple Sclerosis Fund
13. Public Education Fund
14. Round Up River Ranch Fund
15. 9Health Fair Fund

This list represents the exclusion of two funds, which did not meet the level of contributions required to remain on the form: Goodwill Industries Fund and Families in Action for Mental Health Fund. As such, the Round Up River Ranch Fund and 9Health Fair Fund have been removed from the waiting queue established in the referenced statute and added to the bottom of the 2014 form.
