 7 Section 22-35-108 (2)(a), C.R.S., the purpose of this footnote is to specify what portion of this appropriation is intended to be available for the  
 8 Accelerating Students Through Concurrent Enrollment (ASCENT) Program for FY 2017-18. It is the General Assembly's intent that the Department  
 9 of Education be authorized to utilize up to ~~\$4,210,800~~ \$4,213,200 of this appropriation to fund qualified students designated as ASCENT Program  
 10 participants. This amount is calculated based on an estimated 600 FTE participants funded at a rate of ~~\$7,018~~ \$7,022 per FTE pursuant to Section  
 11 22-54-104 (4.7), C.R.S.".
