- 20 (IV) DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION RELATING TO STUDENTS WHO
 21 PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM TO GAUGE THE SUCCESS AT RECRUITING
 22 DEMOGRAPHICALLY UNDERREPRESENTED GROUPS TO THE EDUCATION
 23 PROFESSION.
