Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB18-1353 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 4, strike lines 3 through 8 and substitute:

2 "SECTION 3. Appropriation. (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal
3 year, \$1,853,037 is appropriated to the department of local affairs. This
4 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the
5 department may use this appropriation as follows:

6 (a) \$1,846,959 for use by the division of local government for the
7 defense counsel on first appearance grant program, which amount is
8 based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 0.5
9 FTE;

10 (b) \$4,480 for the purchase of information technology services;
11 and

12 (c) \$1,598 for the purchase of legal services.

13 (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$4,480 is appropriated to the
14 office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
15 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
16 department of local affairs under subsection (1)(b) of this section. To
17 implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
18 information technology services for the department of local affairs.

19 (3) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$1,598 is appropriated to the
20 department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
21 received from the department of local affairs under subsection (1)(c) of
22 this section. To implement this act, the department of law may use this
23 appropriation to provide legal services for the department of local
24 affairs."
