Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB18-193 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 10, after line 7 insert:

2           **"SECTION 3. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal  
3 year, \$40,415 is appropriated to the department of agriculture. This  
4 appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that  
5 the department will require an additional 0.4 FTE. To implement this act,  
6 the department may use this appropriation for occupational rule review.

7           (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$76,887 is appropriated to  
8 the department of education. This appropriation is from the general fund  
9 and is based on an assumption that the department will require an  
10 additional 0.8 FTE. To implement this act, the department may use this  
11 appropriation for occupational rule review.

12           (3) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$40,415 is appropriated to  
13 the department of human services. This appropriation is from the general  
14 fund and is based on an assumption that the department will require an  
15 additional 0.4 FTE. To implement this act, the department may use this  
16 appropriation for occupational rule review.

17           (4) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$40,415 is appropriated to  
18 the department of public health and environment. This appropriation is  
19 from the general fund and is based on an assumption that the department  
20 will require an additional 0.4 FTE. To implement this act, the department  
21 may use this appropriation for occupational rule review.

22           (5) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$2,306,226 is appropriated  
23 to the department of regulatory agencies. This appropriation is from the

1 general fund and is based on an assumption that the department will  
2 require an additional 20.0 FTE. To implement this act, the department  
3 may use this appropriation for occupational rule review.

4 (6) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$153,869 is appropriated to  
5 the department of revenue. This appropriation is from the general fund  
6 and is based on an assumption that the department will require an  
7 additional 1.7 FTE. To implement this act, the department may use this  
8 appropriation for occupational rule review."

9 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

10 Page 1, line 102, strike "**REGULATIONS.**" and substitute "**REGULATIONS,**  
11 **AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**"
