Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB18-206 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 9, strike "(4)(a)" and substitute "(4)(a);
2 and **add** (4)(d)".

3 Page 4, after line 20 insert:

4 "(d) (I) (A) BEGINNING OCTOBER 15, 2018, AND NO LATER THAN
5 OCTOBER 15 EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT
6 A REPORT TO THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE AND TO THE EDUCATION
7 COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND OF THE SENATE, OR
8 THEIR SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, DEMONSTRATING THAT THE INSTITUTIONS
9 INCLUDED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4) HAVE MET RESIDENT ADMISSION AND
10 ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION FOR THE PRIOR
11 FISCAL YEAR.

12 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 24-1-136
13 (11)(a)(I) OF THIS SECTION, THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS IN
14 SUBSECTION (4)(d)(I)(A) OF THIS SECTION CONTINUE INDEFINITELY.

15 (II) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE INSTITUTIONS SHALL ENSURE THAT
16 THE DATA REQUIRED FOR THESE CALCULATIONS IS CONSISTENTLY
17 INCLUDED IN THE STATE'S STUDENT RECORDS DATABASE, INCLUDING DATA
18 ON THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS WITH IN-STATE CLASSIFICATION AND
19 OUT-OF-STATE CLASSIFICATION, THE NUMBER CLASSIFIED AS
20 INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS FOR PURPOSES OF THE CALCULATION, THE
21 RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT STUDENTS CLASSIFIED AS ONLINE ONLY
22 STUDENTS FOR PURPOSES OF THE CALCULATION, AND THE NUMBER OF

1 STUDENTS CLASSIFIED AS COLORADO SCHOLARS PURSUANT TO
2 SUBSECTION (5) OF THIS SECTION. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE BOTH THE
3 NOMINAL NUMBERS OF STUDENTS IN EACH RELEVANT CATEGORY AND THE
4 CALCULATION DEMONSTRATING THE INSTITUTION'S COMPLIANCE WITH
5 THIS SECTION.

6 (III) AS PART OF THE REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS
7 SUBSECTION (4)(d), IN COLLABORATION WITH THE INSTITUTIONS, THE
8 DEPARTMENT SHALL DEMONSTRATE THAT THE INSTITUTIONS ARE
9 COMPLYING WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 23-1-113 (1)(a) THAT
10 REQUIRE THAT THE ACADEMIC ADMISSION STANDARDS FOR STUDENTS WHO
11 DO NOT HAVE IN-STATE STATUS, AS DETERMINED PURSUANT TO SECTION
12 23-7-103, ARE EQUAL TO OR EXCEED THOSE ESTABLISHED FOR
13 DETERMINING ADMISSION OF IN-STATE STUDENTS, AND THE
14 REQUIREMENTS OF 23-1-113.5 (4)(b) OF THIS SECTION, THAT REQUIRE
15 THAT CERTAIN INSTITUTIONS ANNUALLY REPORT INFORMATION
16 DEMONSTRATING THAT QUALIFIED IN-STATE STUDENTS ARE NOT
17 DISPLACED OR DENIED ADMISSION AS A RESULT OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
18 SUBSECTION (4).".

19 Page 4, after line 20 insert:

20 "SECTION 3. Appropriation. For the 2018-19 state fiscal year,
21 \$8,181,450 is appropriated to the department of higher education for use
22 by the regents of the university of Colorado. This appropriation is from
23 student tuition."

24 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

25 Page 1, line 102, strike "COLORADO." and substitute "COLORADO, AND,
26 IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
