Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB18-262 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and  
2 substitute:

3 **"SECTION 1. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal  
4 year, \$3,188,102 is appropriated to the department of higher education.  
5 This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the  
6 department may use this appropriation for the Colorado commission on  
7 higher education's need based grants.

8 (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$7,572,198 is appropriated  
9 to the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the  
10 general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this  
11 appropriation for the college opportunity fund program to be used for  
12 student stipends for students attending state public institutions.

13 (3) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$1,163 is appropriated to the  
14 department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general  
15 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation  
16 for the college opportunity fund program to be used for student stipends  
17 for students attending participating private institutions.

18 (4) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$3,166,752 is appropriated to  
19 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general  
20 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation  
21 for the college opportunity fund program to be used for fee-for-service  
22 contracts with state institutions pursuant to section 23-18-303, C.R.S.

23 (5) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$2,375,268 is appropriated to  
24 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general  
25 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation

1 for the college opportunity fund program to be used for fee-for-service  
2 contracts with state institutions for specialty education programs.

3 (6) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$7,572,198 is appropriated  
4 to the department of higher education. This appropriation is from  
5 reappropriated funds received from the college opportunity fund program  
6 student stipends for students attending state public institutions under  
7 subsection (2) of this section. To implement this act, the department may  
8 use this appropriation as follows:

24 (7) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$3,166,752 is appropriated  
25 to the department of higher education. This appropriation is from  
26 reappropriated funds received from the college opportunity fund program  
27 fee-for-service contracts with state institutions pursuant to section 23-18-  
28 303, C.R.S., under subsection (4) of this section. To implement this act,  
29 the department may use this appropriation as follows:

4 (8) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$2,375,268 is appropriated  
5 to the department of higher education. This appropriation is from  
6 reappropriated funds received from the college opportunity fund program  
7 fee-for-service contracts with state institutions for specialty education  
8 programs, under subsection (5) of this section. To implement this act, the  
9 department may use this appropriation as follows:

10 Board of governors of the Colorado state  
11 university system \$1,107,333  
12 Regents of the university of Colorado \$1,267,935

13 (9) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$144,670 is appropriated to  
14 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general  
15 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation  
16 for local district college grants, pursuant to section 23-71-301, C.R.S., for  
17 Colorado mountain college.

18 (10) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$171,064 is appropriated to  
19 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general  
20 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation  
21 for local district college grants, pursuant to section 23-71-301, C.R.S., for  
22 Aims community college.

23 (11) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$201,961 is appropriated to  
24 the department of higher education for use by the division of occupational  
25 education. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this  
26 act, the division may use this appropriation for area technical colleges.

27 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
28 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
29 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."
