HB19-1031 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, strike lines 23 through 26 and substitute:

2 **"SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
3 takes effect December 1, 2020; except that, if a referendum petition is
4 filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against
5 this act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period
6 after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item,
7 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the
8 general election to be held in November 2020 and, in such case, will take
9 effect December 1, 2020, or on the date of the official declaration of the
10 vote thereon by the governor, whichever is later."

11 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 6.
