Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB19-1327 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 41, after line 24 insert:

2           **"SECTION 14. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal  
3 year, \$1,739,015 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This  
4 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the  
5 department may use this appropriation as follows:

6           (a) \$882,345 for use by the limited gaming division for personal  
7 services, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will  
8 require an additional 11.6 FTE;

9           (b) \$234,416 for use by the limited gaming division for operating  
10 expenses;

11           (c) \$443,500 for tax administration IT system (GenTax) support;

12           (d) \$142,388 for the purchase of legal services;

13           (e) \$34,650 for vehicle lease payments; and

14           (f) \$1,716 for the purchase of criminal history record checks.

15           (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$142,388 is appropriated to  
16 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
17 received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(d) of this  
18 section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will  
19 require an additional 0.8 FTE. To implement this act, the department of  
20 law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the  
21 department of revenue.

22           (3) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$34,650 is appropriated to  
23 the department of personnel. This appropriation is from reappropriated

1 funds received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(e) of  
2 this section. To implement this act, the department of personnel may use  
3 this appropriation to provide vehicles for the department of revenue.

4 (4) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$1,716 is appropriated to the  
5 department of public safety for use by the biometric identification and  
6 records unit. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received  
7 from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(f) of this section. To  
8 implement this act, the unit may use this appropriation to provide criminal  
9 history record checks for the department of revenue."

10 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

11 Page 1, line 105, strike "CASINOS AND" and substitute "CASINOS,".

12 Page 1, line 109, strike "FUND." and substitute "FUND, AND MAKING AN  
13 APPROPRIATION."

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
