BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) Esgar, McCluskie, Ransom, Kipp; also SENATOR(S) Moreno, Zenzinger, Rankin, Tate.

CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Appropriation to the department of personnel for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019. In Session Laws of Colorado 2019, section 2 of chapter 454, (SB 19-207), amend Part XV as follows:

- Department of Personnel, Division of Capital Assets, Fleet Management Program and Motor Pool Services, Vehicle Replacement Lease/Purchase Pursuant to Section 24-82-101 (1)(b) and (1)(c), C.R.S., the Department of Personnel is authorized to enter into a lease-purchase agreement for the approved FY 2019-20 vehicle replacements and additions. The lease-purchase agreement shall be for a period of up to ten years and shall not exceed the amount of \$37,000,000.

SECTION 2. Appropriation to the department of personnel for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019. In Session Laws of Colorado 2019, amend Section 2 of chapter 379, (SB 19-135), as follows:

Section 2. **Appropriation.** For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$650,000 is appropriated to the department of personnel for use by the division of accounts and control. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for operating expenses PERSONAL SERVICES related to procurement and contracts.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
