

HOUSE BILL 21-1235

BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) Bird and Benavidez, Duran, Esgar, Gray, Hooton, McCormick, Mullica, Ricks, Sirota, Valdez A., Bernett, Cutter; also SENATOR(S) Story, Gonzales, Winter.

CONCERNING MEASURES TO IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY THROUGH THE MODIFICATION OF THE REGULATION OF FIREWORKS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-2002, add (7.5), (8.3), (8.5), and (8.7) as follows:

- **24-33.5-2002.** Unlawful use or sale of fireworks exceptions. (7.5) It is unlawful for a person licensed as a retailer pursuant to this part 20 to sell, offer for sale, expose for sale, possess with intent to sell, deliver, consign, or otherwise furnish a firework, except a permissible firework, to another person.
- (8.3) It is unlawful for a person licensed as a display retailer pursuant to this part 20 to sell, offer for sale, expose for sale, possess with intent to sell, deliver, consign, give, or

OTHER WISE FURNISH A FIREWORK, EXCEPT DISPLAY FIREWORKS OR ARTICLES PYROTECHNIC TO A PERSON AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 24-33.5-2003.

- (8.5) It is unlawful for a person licensed as a wholesaler pursuant to this part 20 to sell, offer for sale, expose for sale, possess with intent to sell, deliver, consign, give, or otherwise furnish a firework, except permissible fireworks to a retailer for resale in Colorado.
- (8.7) It is unlawful for a person licensed as an exporter pursuant to this part 20 to sell, offer for sale, expose for sale, possess with intent to sell, deliver, consign, give, or otherwise furnish a firework to a person, except as provided by section 24-33.5-2006.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-2006, **amend** (2) as follows:

- **24-33.5-2006.** Exportation of fireworks. (2) The exporter may transport such fireworks by common carrier or by the exporter's vehicle; except that the sale of the fireworks for transport in the purchaser's vehicle is unlawful unless
- (a) The exporter requires the purchaser to display a valid motor vehicle driver's license issued by a state other than the state of Colorado and records the number and state of issue of such driver's license on the bill of lading pertaining to the sale, and further requires the purchaser to display a valid motor vehicle registration showing that the purchaser owns a motor vehicle licensed in a state other than the state of Colorado, which license plate number and state of issue shall be recorded on the bill of lading pertaining to the sale; or
- (b) the exporter requires the purchaser to display a valid motor vehicle driver's license issued by the state of Colorado and records the number and state JURISDICTION of issue of the driver's license on the bill of lading pertaining to the sale, and further requires the purchaser to furnish a valid EXPORTER OF FIREWORKS LICENSE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS PART 20, OR A VALID wholesale, or retail, license number or resale license number issued by the governing body of a state or local authority located outside of the state of Colorado, which number and state OR LOCAL AUTHORITY of

issue shall MUST be recorded on the bill of lading pertaining to the sale.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
