CONCERNING AMENDING THE ELEMENTS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT TO PROHIBIT  
SEXUAL MISCONDUCT WITHOUT CONSENT.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-3-402, **amend** (1)(a) as follows:

**18-3-402. Sexual assault.** (1) Any actor who knowingly inflicts sexual intrusion or sexual penetration on a victim commits sexual assault if:

(a) The actor ~~causes submission of the victim by means of sufficient~~

**SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability.** This act takes effect  
July 1, 2022, and applies to offenses committed on or after said date.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.




