Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1242 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 41, after line 14 insert:

2 "SECTION 36. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal  
3 year, \$227,612 is appropriated to the department of local affairs. This  
4 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the  
5 department may use this appropriation as follows:

6 (a) \$127,071 for use by the division of housing for manufactured  
7 buildings program, which amount is based on an assumption that the  
8 division will require an additional 1.4 FTE;

9 (b) \$51,256 for use by the executive director's office for legal  
10 services;

11 (c) \$2,379 for use by the executive director's office for vehicle  
12 lease payments; and

13 (d) \$46,906 for use by the executive director's office for payments  
14 to OIT.

15 (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$51,256 is appropriated to  
16 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
17 received from the department of local affairs under subsection (1)(b) of  
18 this section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will  
19 require an additional 0.3 FTE. To implement this act, the department of  
20 law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the  
21 department of local affairs.

22 (3) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$2,379 is appropriated to the  
23 department of personnel. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
24 received from the department of local affairs under subsection (1)(c) of  
25 this section. To implement this act, the department of personnel may use  
26 this appropriation to provide vehicles to the department of local affairs.

27 (4) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$46,906 is appropriated to

1 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.  
2 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the  
3 department of local affairs under subsection (1)(d) of this section. To  
4 implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide  
5 information technology services for the department of local affairs.

6 (5) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$86,946 is appropriated to  
7 the department of regulatory agencies. This appropriation is from the  
8 division of professions and occupations cash fund created in section 12-  
9 20-105 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this  
10 appropriation as follows:

11 (a) \$50,440 for use by the division of professions and occupations  
12 for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the  
13 division will require an additional 0.9 FTE;

14 (b) \$26,989 for use by the division of professions and occupations  
15 for operating expenses; and

16 (c) \$9,517 for use by the executive director's office and  
17 administrative services for vehicle lease payments.

18 (6) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$9,517 is appropriated to the  
19 department of personnel. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
20 received from the department of local affairs under subsection (5)(c) of  
21 this section. To implement this act, the department of personnel may use  
22 this appropriation to provide vehicles to the department of regulatory  
23 agencies."
