CONCERNING A CHANGE TO THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCERNING REGULATIONS FOR TAKING REMOTE TESTIMONY IN COMMITTEES OF REFERENCE.

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, Rule No. 54, **amend** (a) as follows:

54. Regulations for Remote Testimony in Committees

- (a) Pursuant to section 2-2-404 (2), C.R.S., this rule authorizes the Speaker to promulgate regulations to enable government officials and employees as well as other members of the public to testify remotely in legislative proceedings of House committees of reference. ~~held during the first regular legislative session of the Seventy-third General Assembly.~~ Nothing in this rule 54 or any regulations promulgated pursuant to this rule 54 prohibits government officials or employees or other members of the public from testifying in person in legislative proceedings of House committees of reference. The Speaker shall ensure that regulations promulgated pursuant to this subsection (a) are distributed to each member of the House and to the chief clerk of the House and posted on the website of the House.
