Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB22-140 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 33, after line 2 insert:

2 "SECTION 18. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal
3 year, \$6,100,000 is appropriated to the department of labor and
4 employment. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement
5 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

6 (a) \$3,000,000 for state operations and program costs, which
7 amount is based on an assumption that the division of employment and
8 training will require an additional 2.5 FTE;

9 (b) \$2,000,000 for the office of future work, which amount is
10 based on an assumption that the executive director's office will require an
11 additional 1.0 FTE; and

12 (c) \$1,100,000 for the office of new americans, which amount is
13 based on an assumption that the executive director's office will require an
14 additional 3.4 FTE.

15 (2) Any money appropriated in this subsection (1) not expended
16 prior to July 1, 2023, is further appropriated to the department for the
17 2023-24 state fiscal year and subsequent fiscal years for the same
18 purpose.

19 (3) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$11,319 is appropriated to
20 the legislative department for use by the general assembly. This
21 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the general
22 assembly may use this appropriation for per diem and travel
23 reimbursement expenses."

24 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

25 Page 1, line 106, strike "AND".

1 Page 1, line 107, strike "OCCUPATIONS." and substitute "OCCUPATIONS,
2 AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
