Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB22-193 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Energy and Environment Committee Report, dated April 21,
2 2022, page 1, line 15, strike "**donations.**" and substitute "**donations -**
3 **repeal.**".

4 Page 2, strike line 9 and substitute "SOURCES.
5 (4) (a) ON JULY 1, 2022, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER
6 ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL
7 FUND TO THE FUND.
8 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (4) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023."."

9 Page 4, strike lines 5 through 10 and substitute "Page 40, strike lines 26
10 and 27 and substitute:

11 "(4) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$44,365 is appropriated to
12 the department of education for use by assistance to public schools. This
13 appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the department
14 of public health and environment from the electrifying school buses grant
15 program cash fund created in section 25-7-1505 (1)(a), C.R.S. To
16 implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for public
17 school transportation.

18 **SECTION 11. Appropriation - adjustments to 2022**
19 **long bill.** To implement this act, the general fund appropriation made in
20 the annual general appropriation act for the 2022-23 state fiscal year to
21 the office of the governor for use by the Colorado energy office for the
22 cannabis resource optimization program is decreased by \$1,500,000."
