After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB22-196 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 5, strike line 10 and substitute:
2 "(b) A HOSPITAL THAT PROVIDES BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
3 TREATMENT;".
- 4 Page 5, line 19, strike "NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION," and substitute
5 "HOSPITAL THAT PROVIDES BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TREATMENT,".
- 6 Page 5, line 24, strike "NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION," and substitute
7 "HOSPITAL THAT PROVIDES BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TREATMENT,".
- 8 Page 6, line 27, strike "NEEDS, INCLUDING INDIVIDUALS ENGAGED IN
9 COMPETENCY" and substitute "NEEDS".
- 10 Page 7, line 1, strike "EVALUATION OR RESTORATION IN ANY SETTING,".
- 11 Page 8, after line 22 insert:
12 "(h) TO ESTABLISH AND OPERATE, OR FUND AN EXISTING, MOBILE
13 MEDICATION-ASSISTED TREATMENT UNIT;".
- 14 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.
- 15 Page 10, line 6, after "MUST" insert "OFFER A MONETARY CONTRIBUTION
16 OR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS, AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS
17 SECTION, THAT DIRECTLY SUPPORT THE SERVICES PROVIDED WITH A GRANT
18 AWARD AND MUST"
- 19 Page 11, line 21, strike "NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS" and substitute

1 "HOSPITALS".

2 Page 11, line 24, strike "AND".

3 Page 11, after line 24, insert:

4 "(I) IF THE APPLICANT IS A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, THE
5 APPLICANT MUST DEMONSTRATE COMPLIANCE WITH THE REPORTING
6 REQUIREMENTS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 24-31-903 (2); AND".

7 Reletter succeeding paragraph accordingly.

8 Page 12, after line 21 insert:

9 "(B) TWO REPRESENTATIVES OF ORGANIZATIONS WITH EXPERIENCE
10 AWARDING GRANTS IN BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FIELDS;".

11 Reletter succeeding sub-subparagraphs accordingly.

12 Page 13, line 19, after the period add "MEMBERS OF THE REVIEW
13 COMMITTEE SHALL DISCLOSE ANY CONFLICTS OF INTEREST, INCLUDING
14 WHETHER THE MEMBER REPRESENTS AN ORGANIZATION THAT MAY SEEK
15 A GRANT FROM THE GRANT PROGRAM.".

16 Page 17, line 14, strike "AN OPIOID" and substitute "A SUBSTANCE".

17 Page 17, line 15, strike "SETTINGS" and substitute "SETTINGS, INCLUDING
18 PROBATION,".

19 Page 17, line 18, strike "OPIOID" and substitute "A SUBSTANCE".

20 Page 18, strike lines 7 through 10 and substitute "ADMINISTRATIVE
21 EXPENSES. THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOCATE ONE MILLION
22 EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS OF THE MONEY APPROPRIATED
23 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (11) TO RECIPIENTS THAT PROVIDE
24 DIVERSION FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DISORDERS.".

25 Page 19, line 6, strike "HEALTH" and substitute "HEALTH, HOUSING, AND
26 DEMOGRAPHIC".

27 Page 19, strike lines 11 through 17 and substitute "ONE-TIME GRANTS TO
28 COUNTIES. EVERY COUNTY IS ELIGIBLE FOR A GRANT. A COUNTY THAT
29 RECEIVES A GRANT SHALL USE THE GRANT MONEY TO:

30 (I) INTEGRATE THE COUNTY JAIL'S DATA SYSTEMS WITH THE

1 COLORADO INTEGRATED CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM;
2 (II) STANDARDIZE CLIENT-SPECIFIC INFORMATION THROUGH
3 COMMON DATA FIELDS RELATING TO THE BEHAVIORAL, MENTAL, AND
4 PHYSICAL HEALTH NEEDS OF PERSONS DETAINED IN THE JAIL; HOUSING
5 NEEDS FOR PERSONS FOLLOWING RELEASE FROM JAIL; AND DEMOGRAPHIC
6 INFORMATION OF PERSONS DETAINED IN THE JAIL; AND
7 (III) AUTOMATE DATA REPORTING REQUIRED PURSUANT TO STATE
8 AND FEDERAL LAW."

9 Page 19, line 19, strike "GRANTS, WHICH MUST INCLUDE ELIGIBILITY
10 CRITERIA;" and substitute "GRANTS;"

11 Page 19, line 25, after "PUBLIC." insert "THE DIVISION SHALL PROVIDE,
12 UPON REQUEST, ASSISTANCE TO COUNTIES WITH APPLYING FOR A GRANT."

13 Page 20, lines 15 and 16, strike "ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A
14 THIRD-PARTY VENDOR" and substitute "COLLABORATE WITH THE OFFICE
15 OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, CREATED IN SECTION 24-37.5-103,"

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
