Page 3 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 16.
Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
Page 4 of the bill, strike lines 18 through 27.
Page 5 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 12.
Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
Page 6 of the bill, lines 15 and 16, strike "2023-24 AND FOR EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER," and substitute "2024-25".
Page 6 of the bill, line 17, strike SEVEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND" and substitute "THREE MILLION".
Page 6 of the bill, after line 20, insert: "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-32-120, add (1)(c)(V) as follows: 24-32-120. Justice reinvestment crime prevention initiative -
program - rules - cash funds - reports - repeal. (1) (c) (V) (A) ON JULY 1, 2024, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ALL UNEXPENDED

AND UNENCUMBERED MONEY IN THE FUND TO THE STATE DOMESTIC

SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-20.5-801, **amend** (9)(e) as follows:

25-20.5-801. Community crime victims grant program - created - cash fund - repeal. (9) (e) The state treasurer shall transfer all unexpended and unencumbered money in the fund on September 1, 2024, AUGUST 31, 2023, to the general fund.

SECTION 5. Effective date. This act takes effect upon passage; except that section 4 of this act takes effect only if Senate Bill 23-160 does not become law.".
