 - "SECTION 26. Appropriation. (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$338,270 is appropriated to the department of natural resources for use by the oil and gas conservation commission. This appropriation is from the oil and gas conservation and environmental response fund created in section 34-60-122 (5)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the commission may use this appropriation as follows:
 - (a) \$317,122 for program costs, which amount is based on an assumption that the commission will require an additional 3.2 FTE; and
 - (b) \$21,148 for legal services.
 - (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$14,706 is appropriated to the department of public health and environment for use by the air pollution control division. This appropriation is from the general fund, and is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 0.2 FTE. To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for personal services related to stationary sources.
 - (3) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$34,052 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
 - (a) \$7,392 for use by taxation services for operating expenses; and
 - (b) \$26,660 for tax administration IT system (GenTax) support.
 - (4) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$21,148 is appropriated to the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the department of natural resources under subsection (1)(b) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the department of natural resources."
