Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-086 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 10, line 6, strike "**created.**" and substitute
2 "**created - repeal.**", and after "(1)" insert "(a)".

3 Page 10, after line 11, insert:

4 "(b) IF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DOES NOT SPEND THE
5 TOTAL AMOUNT APPROPRIATED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (1) BY THE
6 END OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH IT IS APPROPRIATED, ANY AMOUNT
7 NOT EXPENDED UP TO FIFTY PERCENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT
8 APPROPRIATED IS FURTHER APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE
9 SUBSEQUENT STATE FISCAL YEAR FOR THE SAME PURPOSE."

10 Page 11, after line 9, insert:

11 "(3) (a) ANY MONEY APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
12 HIGHER EDUCATION FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 THAT IS NOT
13 EXPENDED BEFORE JULY 1, 2023, IS FURTHER APPROPRIATED TO THE
14 DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 FOR
15 THE SAME PURPOSE.

16 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (3) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024."

17 Page 11, after line 12 insert:

18 "**SECTION 3. Transfer of appropriation.** Any appropriation
19 made in the annual general appropriation act for the 2023-24 state fiscal
20 year to the department of higher education for the Colorado student
21 leaders institute is hereby transferred to the department of education to

1 implement this act.

2 **SECTION 4. Appropriation.** For the 2023-24 state fiscal year,
3 \$8,184 is appropriated to the department of education. This appropriation
4 is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that the
5 department will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the
6 department may use this appropriation for the Colorado student leaders
7 institute.

8 **SECTION 5. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2023;
9 except that section 22-106-105 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, enacted
10 in section 1 of this act, takes effect June 30, 2023."

11 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

12 Page 1, line 101, strike "MODERNIZATION." and substitute
13 "MODERNIZATION, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AND
14 REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION."
