ONE MEMBER MUST REPRESENT A BUSINESS THAT TRANSPORTS STUDENTS AS DESCRIBED PURSUANT TO SECTION 40-10.1-105 (1)(b) AND IS REGULATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AND ONE MEMBER MUST BE REGULATED BY THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.".
Page 7, line 25 strike "PRESENT" and substitute "PRESENT, AT A MINIMUM,".
