After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-264 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 2, strike "(2)" and substitute "(1)(a)(II),
- (1)(a)(III), (1)(c), and (2); and**add**(2.5)".

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- 3 Page 2, strike lines 4 through 18 and substitute:
 - "44-3-404. Festival permit rules. (1) (a) A person listed in subsection (9) of this section may file a festival permit application with the state licensing authority. The applicant must:
 - (II) File the application at least ten business THIRTY CALENDAR days before the festival is to be held; and
 - (III) Include a twenty-five FIFTY dollar annual processing fee with the application filed with the state licensing authority.
 - (c) If a festival permittee notifies the state licensing authority and the appropriate local licensing authority of the location of and dates of each festival at least ten THIRTY business days before holding the festival, the permittee may hold up to, but no more than, nine festivals during the twelve months after the festival permit is issued. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2024, A PERMITTEE MAY HOLD UP TO NINE FESTIVALS DURING EACH CALENDAR YEAR.
 - (2) The licensee that holds the festival must file the application for the permit, but other licensees may jointly participate under the permit issued to the licensee that applied for the permit, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (2.5) OF THIS SECTION.
- 22 (2.5) A LICENSEE MAY PARTICIPATE IN UP TO FIFTY-TWO FESTIVALS
 23 EACH CALENDAR YEAR, INCLUDING UP TO NINE FESTIVALS HELD UNDER A
 24 FESTIVAL PERMIT ISSUED TO THE LICENSEE PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION
 25 (1)(c) OF THIS SECTION.

- SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect June 1, 2023.
- 2 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
- 3 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

4 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.".

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
