 - (IV) OTHER STANDARDS AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY.
 - (b) A PROGRAM ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2)(a) OF THIS SECTION MUST INCLUDE A WRITTEN POLICY AND PROCEDURE FOR A HOMEOWNER TO SEEK A REASONABLE EXTENSION OF A PROGRAM DEADLINE OR AN EXEMPTION FROM A PROGRAM REQUIREMENT ON THE BASIS OF UNFORSEEN OR EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES OR UNDUE BURDEN, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY.
 - (3) (a) EACH OF THE AFFECTED COUNTIES MUST POST ON A PUBLIC WEBSITE A LIST OF INDIVIDUALS AND ENTITIES THAT PERFORM WILDFIRE MITIGATION SERVICES IN THE COUNTY INCLUDING CONTACT INFORMATION FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS AND ENTITIES LISTED. EACH AFFECTED COUNTY IS ENCOURAGED TO INCLUDE ON THE SAME WEBSITE A COPY OF OR LINK TO:
 - (I) THE IBHS'S WILDFIRE-PREPARED HOME PROGRAM GUIDE, OR A SUCCESSOR PUBLICATION;
 - (II) THE FOREST SERVICE'S PUBLICATION "THE HOME IGNITION ZONE", OR A SUCCESSOR PUBLICATION;
- 31 (III) THE FOREST SERVICE'S WEB-BASED CLEARINGHOUSE FOR 32 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND FUNDING RESOURCES CREATED PURSUANT TO 33 SECTION 23-31-313 (9); AND
- 34 (IV) COUNTY-SPECIFIC TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND FUNDING RESOURCES FOR WILDFIRE MITIGATION BY HOMEOWNERS.".
