SB24-195 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 3, line 3, after the second "portion," insert $"(2)(g)(IV)$,".
Page 3, line 4, after "repeal" insert "(1.5),".
Page 3, line 14, strike "VEHICLE, THE OPERATOR OF THE VEHICLE," and substitute "VEHICLE".
Page 4, strike lines 1 and 2 and substitute:
"(c) "STATE HIGHWAY" MEANS ANY HIGHWAY THAT IS OWNED BY OR OVERSEEN BY THE STATE. (1.5) Except for the authorization contained in subsection (1.7) of this section, nothing in this section applies to a violation detected by an automated vehicle identification system for driving twenty-five miles per hour or more in excess of the reasonable and prudent speed or twenty-five miles per hour or more in excess of the maximum speed limit of seventy-five miles per hour detected by the use of an automated vehicle identification system."
