After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB25-132 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 4, after "(I)" insert "(A)".
- 2 Page 2, strike lines 7 and 8 and substitute "manufacture".
- 3 Page 2, line 9, strike "FIVE" and substitute "THREE".
- 4 Page 2, line 14, strike "FIVE" and substitute "THREE".
- 5 Page 2, after line 15 insert:

6           "(B) A MANUFACTURER OF SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS LICENSED  
7 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION THAT CONDUCTS TASTINGS PURSUANT TO THIS  
8 SUBSECTION (7) MAY APPLY TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY FOR A  
9 PERMIT TO SERVE AND SELL ALCOHOL BEVERAGES ACQUIRED FROM  
10 WHOLESALERS LICENSED IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 44-3-407  
11 AT THE MANUFACTURER'S LICENSED PREMISES OR AT AN APPROVED SALES  
12 ROOM. THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY DETERMINE THE FORM AND  
13 MANNER OF A PERMIT APPLICATION SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO THIS  
14 SUBSECTION (7)(a)(I)(B). IF THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY APPROVES  
15 A PERMIT APPLICATION FILED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (7)(a)(I)(B):  
16 THE MANUFACTURER OF SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS SHALL HAVE SANDWICHES  
17 AND LIGHT SNACKS AVAILABLE FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES, BUT  
18 NEED NOT HAVE MEALS AVAILABLE FOR CONSUMPTION, AND THE SALES  
19 PROCEEDS FROM SALES OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGES ACQUIRED FROM  
20 WHOLESALERS MUST NOT EXCEED FIFTY PERCENT OF THE  
21 MANUFACTURER'S TOTAL SALES PROCEEDS."
