SUBJECT JBC staff recommended conference committee amendments to the Long Bill

The JBC staff recommends that the conference committee on the Long Bill make the changes to appropriations listed in the table that begins on the next page in order to correct technical errors and be consistent with the Joint Budget Committee's original intent. A number of the changes impact the General Fund and make relatively small technical corrections to FTE counts and these are highlighted in the table.

The technical corrections result in a net decrease of \$31,912 total funds, including a decrease of \$302,852 General Fund.
