REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION DESCRIPTIONS

S4/BA5 LETTERNOTE ADJUSTMENTS: The request includes corrections to various cash and reappropriated fund letternotes in the Long Bill. Staff recommends approval of the request.

S5/BA6 TECHNICAL CORRECTION FOR S.B. 23-241: The request includes a net-neutral transfer of 0.2 FTE and \$125,032 General Fund from the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ) Administrative Services Long Bill appropriation to the Office of School Safety (OSS) School Safety Resource Center line item established by S.B. 23-241 (Creation of Office of School Safety). This adjustment relates to the FY 2023-24 impact of H.B. 22-1274 (Sunset Colorado Interagency Working Group on School Safety).

Staff recommends approval of the request and notes that a supplemental add-on will be necessary to adjust the appropriations clause in S.B. 23-241.

S2 CCJJ REPEAL: The request includes a reduction of \$162,869 General Fund and 2.5 FTE for the repeal of the Colorado Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (CCJJ). The continuation of the CCJJ was not enacted due to the failure of S.B. 23-158. The CCJJ consequently expired on September 1, 2023. The total reduction for the repeal is \$212,869 General Fund, but the Department would like to retain \$50,000 to procure a third-party facilitator for the Working Group on Transforming Criminal and Juvenile Justice (TCJJ). Staff recommends the total reduction of \$212,869 General Fund and 2.5 FTE.

Explanation: JBC staff and the Department agree that this request is the result of a technical error in calculating the original appropriation.

DEPARTMENT REQUEST: The request includes a net-neutral transfer of 0.2 FTE and \$125,032 General Fund from the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ) Administrative Services Long Bill appropriation to the Office of School Safety (OSS) School Safety Resource Center line item established by S.B. 23-241 (Creation of Office of School Safety). This adjustment relates to the FY 2023-24 impact of H.B. 22-1274 (Sunset Colorado Interagency Working Group on School Safety).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the request. A supplemental add-on will be necessary to adjust the appropriations clause in S.B. 23-241.

Does JBC staff believe the request meets the Joint Budget Committee's supplemental criteria?

YES

[An emergency or act of God; a technical error in calculating the original appropriation; data that was not available when the original appropriation was made; or an unforeseen contingency.]

Explanation: JBC staff and the Department agree that this request is the result of information that was not available when the original appropriation was made. Senate Bill 23-158 (Sunset CCJJ) failed in the last days of the 2023 legislative session, well after the passage of the FY 2023-24 Long Bill.

DEPARTMENT REQUEST: The request includes a reduction of \$162,869 General Fund and 2.5 FTE for the repeal of the Colorado Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (CCJJ). The continuation of the CCJJ was not enacted due to the failure of S.B. 23-158. The CCJJ consequently expired on September 1, 2023. The total reduction for the repeal is \$212,869 General Fund, but the Department would like to retain \$50,000 to procure a third-party facilitator for the Working Group on Transforming Criminal and Juvenile Justice (TCJJ).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the total reduction of \$212,869 General Fund and 2.5 FTE.

STAFF ANALYSIS: The total FY 2023-24 appropriation for the CCJJ is \$255,443 General Fund, which supports 2.5 FTE. The monthly prorated cost is \$21,287. The CCJJ ended on September 1, 2023, two months into the fiscal year. That means the Department is over-appropriated for ten months of the fiscal year, which equals \$212,870.

Executive Order B 2023 002 created the Working Group on Transforming Criminal and Juvenile Justice (TCJJ). The Working Group's mission is to "study and make recommendations outlining the structure, location, purpose, and composition of a future permanent, multi-disciplinary, evidenced-based entity or entities with dedicated year-round staff to address matters related to criminal and juvenile justice no later than Friday, March 1, 2024, with the preferred outcome of establishing such an entity(ies) in statute." The Executive Order asks the Department of Public Safety to procure a third-party facilitator for TCJJ meetings "within existing State resources."

The request says that retaining \$50,000 of the \$212,870 "...will allow [the Department] to properly support and resource the TCJJ without the need to cut other essential operating expenses within DCJ." The request makes no attempt to support this assertion. In FY 2022-23, the line item that includes funding for the CCJJ reverted \$141,361 General Fund and \$1.8 million cash funds. The total FY 2023-24 Long Bill appropriation for this line item is \$8,088,052, including \$5.4 million General Fund and \$2.1 million cash funds.

Furthermore, this JBC staffer tends to not recommend funding that is tied exclusively to an executive order and not to a related statute. In this case, the executive order occurred in October 2023 and the facilitator has already been hired and is currently facilitating TCJJ meetings. This means that the requested \$50,000 will backfill an expenditure that has already occurred (or is occurring).

If the Committee supports the executive order that created the TCJJ and/or is supportive of the TCJJ's efforts, it should approve the Department's request to retain the \$50,000 General Fund. The General Assembly may also consider backfilling the \$50,000 through the bill that creates the CCJJ successor entity, if such a bill is brought forward.
