FY 2024-25 Description of Incremental Changes

Statewide common policy supplemental requests: The request includes an increase of \$163,836 total funds, including \$1,629 General Fund, for non-prioritized requests associated with statewide common policy requests. The increase is associated with adjustments to the Department's payments for vehicle leases, state property risk management, and to the Office of Information technology (OIT), which are determined through common policies. The prioritized versions of these requests will be presented during the supplemental presentations for the Department of Personnel (vehicle and state property) and Office of the Governor (OIT). The recommendation is pending Committee action on common policy supplementals.

These requests are not prioritized and are not analyzed in this packet. The JBC will act on these items later when it makes decisions regarding common policies.
