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#### Overview of Department

The Secretary of State is one of five independently-elected constitutional officers and serves as the chief election official for the State of Colorado. The Department of State (DOS) is broadly responsible for overseeing elections, registering businesses, and publishing information and records for public use.

#### FY 2024-25 Description of Incremental Changes

**ES1 Initiative petition processing:** The request includes a one-time increase of \$54,000 in cash fund spending authority from the Department of State Cash Fund in FY 2024-25 for increased staffing related to signature verification of initiative and referendum submissions to the Department. The Committee approved staff recommendation for a one-time \$54,000 cash fund appropriation from the Department of State cash fund created in Section 24-21-104 (3)(b), C.R.S., for FY 2023-24 on September 19, 2024. Staff will include the approved adjustments in the supplemental bill for the Department. No further action is required.

**Statewide common policy supplemental requests:** The request includes a decrease of \$345 cash funds for non-prioritized requests associated with statewide common policy requests. The decrease is associated with adjustments to the Department's payments for vehicle leases and state property risk management, which are determined through common policies. The prioritized versions of these requests will be presented during the supplemental presentation

for the Department of Personnel (vehicle and state property). The recommendation is pending Committee action on common policy supplementals.

#### **Committee Action**

Staff recommended and the Committee approved \$54,000 in cash fund spending authority for initiative petition processing on September 19, 2024. This additional spending authority was made necessary by an unexpectedly high number of ballot initiative petitions submitted to the department in July and August of 2024, which required additional resources for signature verification.
